## Florence Sarah LIVERMORE (1877-c. 1955)

**Florence Sarah LIVERMORE**, daughter of Joseph LIVERMORE (c. 1853-) and Alice Sarah Ann FORD (c. 1855-), was born on 20 July 1877 in Maldon, Essex.<sup>1</sup> She appeared in the census in 1881 at Causeway in Maldon - 4, living with parents Joseph (28, sawyer in steam mill) and Alice Sarah Ann (26), brother Frederick Joseph (2), and visitor Ellen Maria FORD (16, mothers sister).<sup>2</sup> Florence appeared in the census in 1891 at 10/11 Mill Lane in Maldon - 13, living with parents Joseph (38, steam sawyer) and Alice S A (36), siblings Frederick J (12, scholar), Herbert T (9, scholar), Edith A (7, scholar), Ellen M (3) and two twin infants not yet named (under 1 month), and grandfather John (81, past work).<sup>3</sup> Florence appeared in the census in 1901 at 8 Silver Street in Maldon - 23, domestic cook, living in the household of Hermann A KROHN (51, company director).<sup>4</sup> Florence married **Harry William AGER** circa 1901 - reg: Maldon Essex..<sup>5</sup> Florence appeared in the census in 1911 at 115 Oxford Street in Preston, Lancashire - 33, living with husband Harry (35, Church Army Evangelist), daughter Elsie (8) and visitor Kate Croskell (37).<sup>6</sup> Florence was recorded on the 1939 Register living at 58 Mount Street in Diss, Norfolk - unpaid domestic duties, b. 20.07.1877.<sup>7</sup> Florence died circa 1955 in Tolleshunt D'Arcy.

Harry William AGER, son of George AGER (c. 1850-c. 1931) and Mary Ann UNKNOWN (c. 1852-c. 1940), was born on 30 November 1875 in Langford, Essex. He was baptised on 13 February 1876 in Langford. He appeared in the census in 1881 at Hatfield Road in Langford - 5, Scholar, living with parents George (30, agricultural labourer) and Mary Ann (27), and siblings Rhoda (3), Bertie (1) and Emily J (1mo).<sup>8</sup> Harry appeared in the census in 1891 at 81 High Hall in Wickham Bishop, Essex - 15 domestic garden boy, living with Fanny LOFTS (40, domestic servant and caretaker).<sup>9</sup> Harry appeared in the census in 1901 in Willingham by Stow, Lincolnshire - 25, Church Army Fvangelist, a visitor in the household of Henry PLOWRIGHT (41, domestic gardener.<sup>10</sup> Harry appeared in the census in 1911 at 115 Oxford Street in Preston - 35, Church Army Evangelist, living with wife Florence (33), daughter Elsie (8) and visitor Kate Croskell (37).<sup>6</sup> Harry was recorded on the 1939 Register living at 58 Mount Street in Diss - Church Army Evangelist, b. 30.11.1875, wartime duties: A.R.P. and St. Johns Ambulance.<sup>11</sup> Harry died on 4 November 1959 in Lowestoft, Suffolk - died in The General Hospital, Lowestoft. Harry had his estate probated on 25 November 1959 in Ipswich, Suffolk - " AGER Harry William of 2 Chapel Road Tolleshunt D'Arcy Essex died 4 November at The General Hospital Lowestoft Probate Ipswich 25 November to Albert William Ruggles retired motor engineer. Effects £1969 11s. 2d.<sup>112</sup> He and Florence Sarah LIVERMORE had the following children:

Elsie Florence AGER (c. 1902-1956). Elsie was born circa 1902.<sup>13</sup> She was baptised on 28 December 1902 in Kingsbury, Warwickshire - father in the Evangelist Church Army.<sup>14</sup> Elsie appeared in the census in 1911 at 115 Oxford Street in Preston - 8, living with parents Harry (35, Church Army Evangelist) and Florence (33), and visitor Kate Croskell (37).<sup>6</sup> Elsie was recorded on the 1939 Register living at 58 Mount Street in Diss - unpaid domestic duties, b. 28.12.1902.<sup>7</sup> Elsie married **Basil R LARKING** circa 1947 - reg: Maldon, Essex..<sup>15</sup> Elsie died on 5 January 1956 in Tolleshunt D'Arcy.<sup>16</sup> She had her estate probated on 24 January 1956 in Ipswich - " LARKING Elsie Florence of 2 Chapel-road Tolleshunt D'Arcy Essex widow died 5 January 1956 Administration Ipswich 24 January to Harry William Ager retired church army official. Effects £1119 2s. 5d.<sup>116</sup>
