1. Descendants of James GOODERHAM (c. 1847-1925)

1. **James GOODERHAM** [910], son of James Burwood GOODERHAM (c. 1813-1899) [917] and Phoebe NUNN (c. 1818-1901) [920], was born c. 1847 in Barking, Suffolk. He was baptised on 21 Feb 1847 in Barking, Suffolk - parents James (farmer) and Phoebe

On 30 Mar 1851, (the 1851 Census), he was living in Barking, Suffolk - 4, living with parents James B (37, farmer of 70 acres employing 2 men and 1 boy) and Phoebe (32), siblings Mary A (9, scholar), Elizabeth (2) and Emma J (2 mos), Hannah MAYHEW (18, housemaid) and Samuel PECK (30, agricultural labourer).¹

James appeared in the 1861 Census in Barking, Suffolk - 14, scholar, living with parents James (47, farmer of 123 acres employing 4 men and 2 boys) and Phoebe (43), siblings Mary Ann (19), Emma J (15, scholar), Amelia A (5, scholar), Ellen A (5, scholar) and George (2mos), and Sarah WILLIAM (16, general servant).²

In the 1871 Census (2 Apr 1871) he appeared in Thorndon, Suffolk - 24, living with parents James (57, farmer of 200 acres employing 6 men and 2 boys) and Phoebe (53), siblings Mary Ann WELLS (27), James (24), Emma J (20), Ellen A (15) and George (10), nephews Harry G WELLS (2) and Walter J WELLS (1), visitor George William KITSON (26), and Jemima STRINGER (19, general domestic servant).³

James married Sarah Jane HILL [939] on 15 Sep 1875 - reg: Hartismere Suffolk.4

At the time of the 1881 Census, James was living at Shorts Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 33, farmer of 80 acres employing 4 men and 1 boy, living with wife Sarah Jane (31), children William H (2) and Ethel Sarah (6 mos), and indoor servant Arthur SMITH (18).⁵

He appeared in the 1891 Census in Diss, Norfolk - widower, 45, farmer, living with children William H (12, scholar), Ethel S (9, scholar) and Maggie [Marjorie] F (6), sister-in-law Ellen HILL (29), Annie M PAGE (16, general servant) and Frank GOWEN (15, farm servant).

James married **Mary GOSTLING** [911] on 14 Jun 1892 in Diss, Norfolk - married by licence, groom 45, a widower, bride 26, a spinster. The marriage was witnessed by T P GOSTLING and Jeannette GOSTLING. The ceremony was conducted by James WELLER, curate.⁷

James appeared in the 1901 Census in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 51, farmer, living with wife Mary (34), children William (12, farmer's son), Thomas G (7), Burwood J (6), Elsey M (5) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).

In the 1911 Census (2 Apr 1911) he appeared at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 62, farmer, living with wife Mary (43), children Thomas Burwood (16, farmer's son), Elsie (15, milliner's apprentice), Monica (13, scholar) and Ernest (6, scholar), and niece Marjorie (14, scholar).

On 19 Jun 1921, (the 1921 Census), he was living in North Lopham, Norfolk - 72y6m, farmer, living with wife Mary (54y11m, farmer's wife), and children James Burwood (27y02m, farmer

assisting father), Elsie Mary (24y07m, dairy work assisting father) and Ernest Meredith (16y03m, farming assisting father).¹⁰

James died on 28 Nov 1925 in North Lopham, Norfolk - aged 78. 11 12 He had his estate probated on 4 Feb 1926 in Norwich, Norfolk - "GOODERHAM James of North Lopham Norfolk died 28 November 1925 Probate Norwich 4 February [1926] to Mary Gooderham widow and John Coulson Symonds auctioneer. Effects £4306 10s. 6d.". 11

Sarah Jane HILL [939], daughter of William HILL (c. 1824-) [997] and Jane Elizabeth HART (c. 1820-) [998], was born on 16 Jun 1849 in Hoxne, Suffolk.¹³

She was baptised on 15 Jul 1849.

She appeared in the census on 3 Apr 1881 at Shorts Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 31, living with husband James (33, farmer of 80 acres employing 4 men and 1 boy), children William H (2) and Ethel Sarah (6 mos), and indoor servant Arthur SMITH (18)⁵

She died on 10 Mar 1891 in Diss Heywood, Norfolk. 14 She was buried on 16 Mar 1891 - detailed in the Quaker Published Memorials. On 18 Mar 1891 there was a newspaper report in the The Suffolk and Essex Free Press:

DEATHS.

GOODERHAM. - March 10, at Oak Farm, Diss, very suddenly, Sarah Jane, the wife of James Gooderham, aged 41 years.

Mary GOSTLING [911], daughter of Thomas GOSTLING (c. 1827-c. 1908) [918] and Mary Ann STEGGALL (c. 1829-c. 1893) [943], was born c. 1866 in Islington, Middlesex. ¹⁵

She appeared in the census on 31 Mar 1901 in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 34, living with husband James (51, farmer), children William (12, farmer's son), Thomas G (7), Burwood J (6), Elsey M (5) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).⁸

In the 1911 Census (2 Apr 1911) she appeared at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 43, living with husband James (62, farmer), children ThomasBurwood (16, farmer's son), Elsie (15, milliner's apprentice), Monica (13, scholar) and Ernest (6, scholar), and niece Marjorie (14, scholar).⁹

At the time of the 1921 Census, Mary was living in North Lopham, Norfolk - 54y11m, farmer's wife, living with husband James (72y6m, farmer), and children James Burwood (27y02m, farmer assisting father), Elsie Mary (24y07m, dairy work assisting father) and Ernest Meredith (16y03m,

farming assisting father).10

Mary was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Police House in Trowse, Norfolk - widow, b. 28 Jul 1866, unpaid domestic duties, living with daughter and son-in-law Monica M GOODERHAM (b. 22 Aug 1897, unpaid domestic duties) and Wilfred GOODERHAM (b. 2 Nov 1894, Police Officer).¹⁶

She died c. 1947.

2. **William Hill GOODERHAM** [940], son of James GOODERHAM [910] and Sarah Jane HILL [939], was born on 16 Nov 1878 in Thorndon, Suffolk.¹⁷

He appeared in the census on 3 Apr 1881 at Shorts Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 2, living with parents James (33, farmer of 80 acres employing 4 men and 1 boy) and Sarah Jane (31), sister Ethel Sarah (6 mos), and indoor servant Arthur SMITH (18).⁵

He appeared in the census on 5 Apr 1891 in Diss, Norfolk - 12, scholar, living with father James (widower, 45, farmer), sisters Ethel S (9, scholar) and Maggie [Marjorie] F (6), aunt Ellen HILL (29), Annie M PAGE (16, general servant) and Frank GOWEN (15, farm servant).

William appeared in the 1901 Census in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 22, farmer's son, living with parents James (51, farmer) and Mary (34), half siblings Thomas G (7), Burwood J (6), Elsey M (5) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).⁸

In 1906 the Electoral Register showed him living at in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - LODGER'S LIST - Parliamentary and Parochial Electors - H1113: Bedroom, first floor, furnished; Diss Heywood; James Gooderham [father], Diss Heywood..

William and **Sallie Bessie HERN** [980] had marriage banns published on 18 Oct 1908 - other dates were 25 Oct 1908 and 1 Nov 1908. He married her on 3 Nov 1908 in Diss, Norfolk - marriage after banns; groom: single, 29, farmer; bride: 29, spinster. The marriage was witnessed by Arthur CUSHING and Emma Edith Maude HERN. The ceremony was conducted by Rev. C. MANNING. 19 20

On 6 Nov 1908 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk and Suffolk Journal and Diss Express:

MARRIAGES.

GOODERHAM - HERN. - November 3rd. at St, Mary's Church, Diss, by the Rev. C. U. Manning, Rector, William Hill, eldest son of Mr. James Gooderham, North Lopham, to Sallie Bessie, second daughter of George Hern, Diss, and grand-daughter of the late John Simonds, Gissing.

On 2 Apr 1911, (the 1911 Census), he was living at Harling Road in North Lopham, Norfolk - 32, farmer, living with wife Sallie Bessie (31, assisting in the business) and son George James (1).²¹

In the 1921 Census (19 Jun 1921) he appeared in North Lopham, Norfolk - 41, farmer, living with wife Sallie Bessie (40, home duties) and sons George James (11), John William (9), Arthur Robert (8) and Harold Norman (6).²²

William was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Holly Farm in Wortham, Suffolk. - b. 16 Nov 1878. general work on farm, living with wife Sallie B (b. 6 Aug 1879, unpaid domestic duties), children John W (b. 30 Jun 1911, farmer) and Harold N (b. 9 Aug 1914, farmer), Alfred RIGBY (b. 24 Apr 1926, scholar) and Robert E RIGBY (b. 23 Dec 1927, scholar)...²³

William died on 25 Sep 1949 in Wortham, Suffolk.²⁴ He was buried on 29 Sep 1949 in Redgrave, Suffolk. On 30 Sep 1949 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk and Suffolk Journal and Diss Express:

Births, Marriages, Deaths, etc. DEATH

GOODERHAM. - On September 25th, 1949, at Holly Farm, Wortham, Diss, William Hill passed peacefully away, aged 70 years. At rest.

It is possible that William was in the 3rd Bn. 5th Reg. of the Lincolnshire Regiment during the Great War, L.Cpl. 4733 (241487).

Sallie Bessie HERN [980], daughter of George HERN (c. 1838-) [987] and Ann Maria SIMONDS (c. 1845-) [989], was born on 6 Aug 1879 in Diss, Norfolk.^{25 26} She was baptised on 7 Sep 1879 in Diss, Norfolk.²⁶

In the 1911 Census (2 Apr 1911) she appeared at Harling Road in North Lopham, Norfolk - 31, assisting in the business, living with husband William Hill (32, farmer) and son George James (1).²¹

On 19 Jun 1921, (the 1921 Census), she was living in North Lopham, Norfolk - 40, home duties, living with husband William Hill (41, farmer) and sons George James (11), John William (9), Arthur Robert (8) and Harold Norman (6).²²

Sallie was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Holly Farm in Wortham, Suffolk - b. 6 Aug 1879, unpaid domestic duties, living with husband William H (b. 16 Nov 1878. general work on farm), children John W (b. 30 Jun 1911, farmer) and Harold N (b. 9 Aug 1914, farmer), Alfred RIGBY (b. 24 Apr 1926, scholar) and Robert E RIGBY (b. 23 Dec 1927, scholar).²³

Sallie died c. 1948 - age 68.²⁷ Sallie was buried on 1 Apr 1948 in Redgrave, Suffolk. On 9 Apr 1948 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk and Suffolk Journal and Diss Express:

Redgrave FUNERAL

The funeral took place at St. Mary's Church on Thursday week of Mrs. Sallie Bessie Gooderham.

The service was conducted by the Rev. L. Holt Wilson and deceased's favourite hymns "Abide with me" and "Jesu, lover of soul" were sung, and appropriate music was played by the organist, Mr. Armstrong.

The family mourners were: The widower; Messrs. George, Jack, Arthur and Harold Gooderham, sons; Mesdames Arthur, George, Jack and Harold Gooderham, daughters-in-law; Mrs. A. Cushing and Mrs. A. Madgett, sisters; Mr. A. Madgett, Mr. E. Gooderham, and Miss E. Gooderham, brothers-in-law and sister-in-law; Mr. A. Cushing, Diss Heywood.

She and William Hill GOODERHAM had the following children:

In the 1881 Census (3 Apr 1881) she appeared at Shorts Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 6 mos, living with parents James (33, farmer of 80 acres employing 4 men and 1 boy) and Sarah Jane (31), brother William H (2), and indoor servant Arthur SMITH (18).⁵

On 5 Apr 1891, (the 1891 Census), she was living in Diss, Norfolk - 9, scholar, living with father James (widower, 45, farmer), siblings William H (12, scholar) and Maggie [Marjorie] F (6), aunt Ellen HILL (29), Annie M PAGE (16, general servant) and Frank GOWEN (15, farm servant).

Ethel died c. 1971.

4. **Marjorie Florence GOODERHAM** [942], daughter of James GOODERHAM [910] and Sarah Jane HILL [939], was born c. 1884.

At the time of the 1891 Census, Marjorie was living in Diss, Norfolk - 6, living with father James (widower, 45, farmer), siblings William H (12, scholar) and Ethel S (9, scholar), aunt Ellen HILL (29), Annie M PAGE (16, general servant) and Frank GOWEN (15, farm servant).

Marjorie died c. 1966.

5. **Thomas Gostling GOODERHAM**²⁸ [916], son of James GOODERHAM [910] and Mary GOSTLING

[911], was born on 18 Apr 1893 in Diss, Norfolk.²⁹

Thomas appeared in the 1901 Census in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 7, living with parents James (51, farmer) and Mary (34), siblings William (12, farmer's son), James Burwood J (6), Elsey M (5) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).⁸

In the 1911 Census (1911) he appeared at 28 Norman Avenue in Twickenham, Middlesex - 17, chemist's apprentice, boarding in the household of Harris William WILLIS (42, dress buyer) and family.³⁰

Btw 30 May 1916 and 3 Sep 1914 Thomas served as an orderly with the British Red Cross Volunteers at the Star and Garter Home in Richmond, Surrey.

Thomas married **Annie J CHAPMAN** [950] c. 1920 - reg: Hartismere Suffolk.³¹

On 19 Jun 1921, (the 1921 Census), he was living at 130 Victoria Road in Diss, Norfolk - 28, chemists assistant and dispenser working for Gostling and Company, Chemists, Diss, and his wife Annie Jane GOODERHAM (26, home duties), both boarding with Philip ELSEY (77, farmer, retired).³²

Thomas was listed in the in 1937 Kelly's Directory: Ipswich: Gooderham Thos. G. photographic dir. 188 St. Helen's Street.

He was recorded on the 1939 Register living at 188 St. Helens Street in Ipswich, Suffolk - b. 18 Apr 1893, retail chemist, living with wife Annie J (b. 18 Sep 1894, unpaid domestic duties).

He died on 25 Jul 1957 in Ipswich, Suffolk - reg: Ipswich Suffolk.^{33 34} He had his estate probated on 18 Sep 1957 in Ipswich, Suffolk - GOODERHAM Thomas Gostling of 188 St. Helens-street Ipswich died 25 July 1957 Administration Ipswich 18 September [1957] to Annie Jane Gooderham widow. Effects £1762 19s. 10d.³⁴

Annie J CHAPMAN [950] was born on 18 Sep 1894. She died c. 1982.

6. **James Burwood GOODERHAM** [912], son of James GOODERHAM [910] and Mary GOSTLING [911], was born on 5 Apr 1894 in Diss Heywood, Norfolk.³⁵

He appeared in the census on 31 Mar 1901 in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 6, living with parents James (51, farmer) and Mary (34), siblings William (12, farmer's son), Thomas G (7), Elsey M (5) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).⁸

James appeared in the 1911 Census at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 16, farmer's son, living with parents James (62, farmer) and Mary (43), siblings Elsie (15, milliner's apprentice), Monica (13, scholar) and Ernest (6, scholar), and cousin Marjorie (14, scholar).

In the 1921 Census (19 Jun 1921) he appeared in North Lopham, Norfolk - 27y02m, farmer

assisting father, living with parents James (72y6m, farmer) and Mary (54y11m, farmer's wife), and siblings Elsie Mary (24y07m, dairy work assisting father) and Ernest Meredith (16y03m, farming assisting father).¹⁰

James married Elsie May BUSH [935] c. 1928 - reg: Thetford Norfolk.³⁶

He was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Noddle Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - b. 5 Apr 1894, dairy farmer, living with wife Elsie M (b. 11 Dec 1903, unpaid domestic duties) with 4 closed records.³⁷

He died on 10 Nov 1967 in North Lopham, Norfolk - age 73.38 He had his estate probated on 6 Nov 1968 in Norwich, Norfolk - "GOODERHAM James Burwood of Dairy Farm North Lopham Norfolk died 10 November 1967 Probate Norwich 6 November [1968]. £26347.".39

Elsie May BUSH [935], daughter of Herbert Benjamin BUSH (c. 1869-) [954] and Edith Maria DAVY (c. 1869-) [955], was born on 11 Dec 1903 in North Lopham, Norfolk.⁴⁰ ⁴¹

At the time of the 1911 Census, Elsie was living at Chimney Mills, Lopham Road in Kenninghall, Norfolk - 7, living with parents Herbert Benjamin (42, corn miller) and Edith Maria (42), and siblings Herbert Percival (18, miller's carter), Samuel John (16, miller), Claude Sidney C (14, groom), Ernest Edward (12, scholar), Gertrude Ellen (11, scholar), Harold Benjamin (4), Mildred Edith (1) and Thomas William (7 mos).⁴²

In the 1921 Census (19 Jun 1921) she appeared in Ranworth, Norfolk - 18, useful help, living in the household of Ellen YOUNGS (widow, 62, farmer) and her family.⁴³

Elsie was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Noddle Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - b. 11 Dec 1903, unpaid domestic duties, living with husband James B (b. 5 Apr 1894, dairy farmer) with 4 closed records.³⁷

She died on 29 Jan 1978 in North Lopham, Norfolk - age 89, b. 8 Nov 1895 [?]. 44 41 She had her estate probated on 28 Apr 1978 in Ipswich, Suffolk - GOODERHAM, Elsie May of The Bungalow Dairy Farm North Lopham Diss Norfolk died 29 February 1978 Probate Ipswich 28 April [1978], £5053. 781101473T. 44

At the time of the 1901 Census, Elsie was living in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 5, living with parents James (51, farmer) and Mary (34), siblings William (12, farmer's son), Thomas G (7), Burwood J (6) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17,

farm yard boy).para>. On 2 Apr 1911, (the 1911 Census), she was living at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 15, milliner's apprentice, living with parents James (62, farmer) and Mary (43), siblings James Burwood (16, farmer's son), Monica (13, scholar) and Ernest (6, scholar), and cousin Marjorie (14, scholar).

Elsie appeared in the 1921 Census in North Lopham, Norfolk - 24y07m, dairy work assisting father, living with parents James (72y6m, farmer) and Mary (54y11m, farmer's wife), and siblings James Burwood (27y02m, farmer assisting father) and Ernest Meredith (16y03m, farming assisting father).¹⁰

Elsie was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Cottage with Outhouses in North Lopham, Norfolk - b. 8 Nov 1895, single, poultry farmer, living with 4 others.⁴⁷

She died c. 1985.45

8. **Monica May GOODERHAM** [914], daughter of James GOODERHAM [910] and Mary GOSTLING [911], was born c. 1897 in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - reg: Depwade Norfolk.⁴⁸

Monica appeared in the 1901 Census in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 3, living with parents James (51, farmer) and Mary (34), siblings William (12, farmer's son), Thomas G (7), Burwood J (6) and Elsey M (5), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).

In the 1911 Census (2 Apr 1911) she appeared at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 13, scholar, living with parents James (62, farmer) and Mary (43), siblings James Burwood (16, farmer's son), Elsie (15, milliner's apprentice) and Ernest (6, scholar), and cousin Marjorie (14, scholar).

Monica married Wilfred PICKERING [951] c. 1920 - reg: Thetford Norfolk.49

At the time of the 1921 Census, Monica was living at The Terrace, The Street in Scole, Norfolk - 23, home duties, living with husband Wilfred (26, engineer on HMAR 33 Pulham Air Station). 50

Monica was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Police House in Trowse, Norfolk - b. 22 Aug 1897, unpaid domestic duties, living with husband Wilfred (b. 2 Nov 1894, Police Officer) and mother Mary GOODERHAM (widow, b. 28 Jul 1866, unpaid domestic duties). 16

She died on 26 Jul 1987 in Norwich, Norfolk. She had her estate probated on 4 Sep 1987 in Ipswich, Suffolk - "PICKERING, Monica May of 7 Brabazon Rd Norwich died 26 July 1987 Administration with Will Ipswich 4 September. Not exceeding £70000. 8781302249E". 51

Wilfred PICKERING [951] was born on 2 Nov 1894.¹⁶

In the 1921 Census (19 Jun 1921) he appeared at The Terrace, The Street in Scole, Norfolk - 26, engineer on HMAR 33 Pulham Air Station, living with wife Monica M (23, home duties). 50

Wilfred was recorded on the 1939 Register living at Police House in Trowse, Norfolk - b. 2 Nov 1894, Police Officer, living with wife Monica M (b. 22 Aug 1897, unpaid domestic duties) and

mother-in-law Mary GOODERHAM (widow, b. 28 Jul 1866, unpaid domestic duties).¹⁶

He died c. 1982.⁵² He and Monica May GOODERHAM had the following children:

Ernest appeared in the 1911 Census at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 6, scholar, living with parents James (62, farmer) and Mary (43), siblings James Burwood (16, farmer's son), Elsie (15, milliner's apprentice) and Monica (13, scholar), and cousin Marjorie (14, scholar).
