In the 1841 Census (6 Jun 1841) he appeared at The Green in Hoo, Suffolk 58, farmer, living with wife Ann (55), children James (24) and Mary-Ann (20), Ann MALDEN (20, dressmaker), Harriett TRICKER (20, female servant), and Samuel PECK (20, agricultural labourer).⁴ John died on 2 Feb 1850 in Charsfield, Suffolk. He was buried on 8 Feb 1850 in Charsfield, Suffolk surname spelt GOODERAM.⁵

Ann BURWOOD [926] was born c. 1782. She appeared in the census on 6 Jun 1841 at The Green in Hoo, Suffolk - 55, living with husband James (58, farmer), children James (24) and Mary-Ann (20), Ann MALDEN (20, dressmaker), Harriett TRICKER (20, female servant), and Samuel PECK (20, agricultural labourer). In the 1851 Census (30 Mar 1851) she appeared at Hoo Green in Hoo, Suffolk - widow, 69, farmer of 48 acres employing 3 labourers, living with daughter Maryann (34), visitor Ann MAULDING (35, dressmaker), and servants Martha MAYS (47, house servant), Suesaner GARROD (23, house servant) and John BRANTON, farm servant). The Will of John Gooderham formerly of Halesworth but late of Framsden both in the County of Suffolk Gentleman who died 23 November 1886 at Framsden was proved at Ipswich by Rhoda Gooderham of Framsdem Widow the Relict and John Burwood Gooderham of the ""Duke's Head" Hotel Great Yarmouth ib the county of Norfolk Inn-keepeer the Son the Executor,".

- James Burwood GOODERHAM [917], son of John GOODERHAM [925] and Ann BURWOOD [926], 16. was born c. 1813 in Charsfield, Suffolk. 14 He was baptised on 31 Oct 1813 in Charsfield, Suffolk parents John and Ann (nee Burwood). 14 In the 1841 Census (6 Jun 1841) he appeared at The Green in Hoo, Suffolk - 24, living with parents James (58, farmer) and Ann (55), sister Mary-Ann (20), Ann MALDEN (20, dressmaker), Harriett TRICKER (20, female servant), and Samuel PECK (20, agricultural labourer). 4 James married **Phoebe NUNN** [920] c. 1847 - reg: Plomesgate Suffolk. 15 He appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 in Barking, Suffolk - 37, farmer of 70 acres employing 2 men and 1 boy, living with wife Phoebe (32), children Mary A (9, scholar), James (4), Elizabeth (2) and Emma J (2 mos), Hannah MAYHEW (18, housemaid) and Samuel PECK (30, agricultural labourer). 16 At the time of the 1861 Census, James was living in Barking, Suffolk - 47, farmer of 123 acres employing 4 men and 2 boys, living with wife Phoebe (43), children Mary Ann (19), James (14, scholar), Emma J (15, scholar), Amelia A (5, scholar), Ellen A (5, scholar) and George (2mos), and Sarah WILLIAM (16, general servant). ¹⁷ James appeared in the census on 2 Apr 1871 in Thorndon, Suffolk - 57, farmer of 200 acres employing 6 men and 2 boys, living with wife Phoebe (53), children Mary Ann WELLS (27), James (24), Emma J (20), Ellen A (15) and George (10), grandsons Harry G WELLS (2) and Walter J WELLS (1), visitor George William KITSON (26), and Jemima STRINGER (19, general domestic servant). 18 He was listed in the in 1874 Kelly's Directory of Suffolk: FARMERS - Gooderham James Burwood, Lambpits, Thorndon, Eye. He was listed in the in 1879 Post Office Directory of Suffolk: THORNDON - COMMERCIAL - Gooderham James Burwood, farmer, Lambpits. On 3 Apr 1881, (the 1881 Census), he was living at Lamppits Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 67, farmer out of business, living with wife Phoebe (61), children

Emma (29), Ellen (23) and George (20), visitors son-in-law Robert J HAMMOND (32, farm bailiff out of work), his wife Milly [Amelia] HAMMOND (27) and their children Topsy HAMMOND (5) and Thomas E HAMMOND (2), and granddaughter Ellen S WELLS (9, scholar). James appeared in the census on 5 Apr 1891 at Bridge Green in Burston, Norfolk - 77, retired farmer, living with wife Phoebe (75) and daughter Janie (40, married with surname of GILL). He died on 14 May 1899 in Thorndon, Suffolk - reg: Depwade Norfolk. He is commorated in All Saints Churchyard Thorndon, Suffolk - "LOVING MEMORY / JAMES BURWOOD GOODERHAM, / DIED MAY 14TH 1899. / AGED 85 YEARS. / "LO, I AM WITH YOU ALWAY, EVEN UNTO THE END." / WITH THY PRESENCE I CAN CONQUER, / I CAN SUFFER, I CAN DIE, / OTHERWISE I FAINT AND LANGUISH, / OH MY SAVIOUR, BE THOU NIGH. / ALSO OF / PHOEBE GOODERHAM / HIS BELOVED WIFE / DIED MARCH 23RD 1901 / IN THE 84TH YEAR OF HER AGE. / FORMERLY OF LAMBPITS FARM OF THIS PARISH. / IN THY PRESENCE IF FULNESS OF JOY AT THY RIGHT / HAND THERE ARE PLEASURES FOR EVERMORE." . Phoebe NUNN [920], daughter of David NUNN (c. 1786-) [938] and Phoebe UNKNOWN (-) [1019], was born c. 1818 in Brandeston, Suffolk. She was baptised on 8 Mar 1818 in Brandeston, Suffolk - parents David and Phoebe.²⁴ She appeared in the census on 6 Jun 1841 at The Green in Hoo, Suffolk - 20, living with father David (55, agricultural labourer) and brother John (15). She appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 in Barking, Suffolk - 32, living with husband James B (37, farmer of 70 acres employing 2 men and 1 boy), children Mary A (9, scholar), James (4), Elizabeth (2) and Emma J (2 mos), Hannah MAYHEW (18, housemaid) and Samuel PECK (30, agricultural labourer). 16 She appeared in the census on 7 Apr 1861 in Barking, Suffolk - 43, living with husband James (47, farmer of 123 acres employing 4 men and 2 boys), children Mary Ann (19), James (14, scholar), Emma J (15, scholar), Amelia A (5, scholar), Ellen A (5, scholar) and George (2mos), and Sarah WILLIAM (16, general servant). The appeared in the census on 2 Apr 1871 in Thorndon, Suffolk - 52, living with husband James B (57, farmer of 200 acres employing 6 men and 2 boys), children Mary Ann WELLS (27), James (24), Emma J (20), Ellen A (15) and George (10), grandsons Harry G WELLS (2) and Walter J WELLS (1), visitor George William KITSON (26), and Jemima STRINGER (19, general domestic servant). 18 She appeared in the census on 3 Apr 1881 at Lamppits Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 61, living with husband James B (67, farmer out of business), children Emma (29), Ellen (23) and George (20), visitors son-in-law Robert J HAMMOND (32, farm bailiff out of work), his wife Milly [Amelia] HAMMOND (27) and their children Topsy HAMMOND (5) and Thomas E HAMMOND (2), and granddaughter Ellen S WELLS (9, scholar). 19 She appeared in the census on 5 Apr 1891 at Bridge Green in Burston, Norfolk - 75, living with husband James (77, retired farmer) and daughter Janie (40, married with surname of GILL).²⁰ She died on 23 Mar 1901 in Thorndon, Suffolk - aged 83.²⁶ She is commorated in All Saints Churchyard Thorndon, Suffolk- "LOVING MEMORY / JAMES BURWOOD GOODERHAM, / DIED MAY 14TH 1899. / AGED 85 YEARS. / "LO, I AM WITH YOU ALWAY, EVEN UNTO THE END." / WITH THY PRESENCE I CAN CONQUER, / I CAN SUFFER, I CAN DIE, / OTHERWISE I FAINT AND LANGUISH, / OH MY SAVIOUR, BE THOU NIGH. / ALSO OF / PHOEBE GOODERHAM / HIS BELOVED WIFE / DIED MARCH 23RD 1901 / IN THE 84TH YEAR OF HER AGE. / FORMERLY OF LAMBPITS FARM OF THIS PARISH. / IN THY PRESENCE IF FULNESS OF JOY AT THY RIGHT / HAND THERE ARE PLEASURES FOR EVERMORE.".²² She and James Burwood GOODERHAM had the following children:

She was baptised on 25 May 1817 in Charsfield, Suffolk parents John (farmer) and Ann. ²⁷ She appeared in the census on 6 Jun 1841 at The Green in Hoo, Suffolk 20, living with parents James (58, farmer) and Ann (55), brother James (24), Ann MALDEN (20, dressmaker), Harriett TRICKER (20, female servant), and Samuel PECK (20, agricultural labourer). ⁴ She appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 at Hoo Green in Hoo, Suffolk 35, living with mother Ann (widow, 69, farmer of 48 acres employing 3 labourers), visitor Ann MAULDING (35, dressmaker), and servants Martha MAYS (47, house servant), Suesaner GARROD (23, house servant) and John BRANTON, farm servant). ⁶ She died on 29 May 1859. She was buried on 3 Jun 1859 in Charsfield, Suffolk aged 42. ²⁸ On 4 Jun 1859 there was a newspaper report in the The Suffolk Chronicle:

DIED.

On the 29th ult, at Hoo, in her 42nd year, Mary Ann, eldest daughter of the late Mr. John Gooderham.

in Fareham, Hampshire.

Mary Ann GOODERHAM [919], daughter of James Burwood GOODERHAM [917] and Phoebe NUNN [920], was born c. 1841 in Hoo, Suffolk.³¹ She appeared in the census on 30 Mar 1851 in Barking, Suffolk - 9, scholar, living with parents James B (37, farmer of 70 acres employing 2 men and 1 boy) and Phoebe (32), siblings James (4), Elizabeth (2) and Emma J (2 mos), Hannah MAYHEW (18, housemaid) and Samuel PECK (30, agricultural labourer).¹⁶ She appeared in the census on 7 Apr 1861 in Barking, Suffolk - 19, living with parents James (47, farmer of 123 acres employing 4 men and 2 boys) and Phoebe (43), siblings James (14, scholar), Emma J (15, scholar), Amelia A (5, scholar), Ellen A (5, scholar) and George (2mos), and Sarah WILLIAM (16, general servant).¹⁷ She married Emanuel WELLS [949] c. 1867 - reg: Hartismere Suffolk.³² She appeared in the census on 2 Apr 1871 in Thorndon, Suffolk - 27, married nee WELLS, living with parents James (57, farmer of 200 acres employing 6 men and 2 boys) and Phoebe (53), siblings James (24), Emma J (20), Ellen A (15) and George (10), sons Harry G WELLS (2) and Walter J WELLS (1), visitor George William KITSON (26), and Jemima STRINGER (19, general domestic servant).¹⁸ She died c. 1878 in Thorndon, Suffolk.³³ She was buried on 8 Oct 1878 in Thorndon, Suffolk.

Either Mary Ann is the daughter of Phoebe 6 years before their marriage or is the daughter of an unknown mother.

On 30 Mar 1851, (the 1851 Census), he was living in Barking, Suffolk - 4, living with parents James B (37, farmer of 70 acres employing 2 men and 1 boy) and Phoebe (32), siblings Mary A (9, scholar), Elizabeth (2) and Emma J (2 mos), Hannah MAYHEW (18, housemaid) and Samuel PECK (30, agricultural labourer).¹⁶

James appeared in the 1861 Census in Barking, Suffolk - 14, scholar, living with parents James (47, farmer of 123 acres employing 4 men and 2 boys) and Phoebe (43), siblings Mary Ann (19), Emma J (15, scholar), Amelia A (5, scholar), Ellen A (5, scholar) and George (2mos), and Sarah WILLIAM (16, general servant).¹⁷

In the 1871 Census (2 Apr 1871) he appeared in Thorndon, Suffolk - 24, living with parents James (57, farmer of 200 acres employing 6 men and 2 boys) and Phoebe (53), siblings Mary Ann WELLS (27), James (24), Emma J (20), Ellen A (15) and George (10), nephews Harry G WELLS (2) and Walter J WELLS (1), visitor George William KITSON (26), and Jemima STRINGER (19, general domestic servant).¹⁸

James married Sarah Jane HILL [939] on 15 Sep 1875 - reg: Hartismere Suffolk.35

At the time of the 1881 Census, James was living at Shorts Farm in Thorndon, Suffolk - 33, farmer of 80 acres employing 4 men and 1 boy, living with wife Sarah Jane (31), children William H (2) and Ethel Sarah (6 mos), and indoor servant Arthur SMITH (18).³⁶

He appeared in the 1891 Census in Diss, Norfolk - widower, 45, farmer, living with children William H (12, scholar), Ethel S (9, scholar) and Maggie [Marjorie] F (6), sister-in-law Ellen HILL (29), Annie M PAGE (16, general servant) and Frank GOWEN (15, farm servant).³⁷

James married **Mary GOSTLING** [911] on 14 Jun 1892 in Diss, Norfolk - married by licence, groom 45, a widower, bride 26, a spinster. The marriage was witnessed by T P GOSTLING and Jeannette GOSTLING. The ceremony was conducted by James WELLER, curate.³⁸

James appeared in the 1901 Census in Diss Heywood, Norfolk - 51, farmer, living with wife Mary (34), children William (12, farmer's son), Thomas G (7), Burwood J (6), Elsey M (5) and Monica M (3), and servants Alice HULLS (19, domestic servant) and Robert ELMER (17, farm yard boy).³⁹

In the 1911 Census (2 Apr 1911) he appeared at Dairy Farm in North Lopham, Norfolk - 62, farmer, living with wife Mary (43), children Thomas Burwood (16, farmer's son), Elsie (15, milliner's apprentice), Monica (13, scholar) and Ernest (6, scholar), and niece Marjorie (14, scholar).⁴⁰

On 19 Jun 1921, (the 1921 Census), he was living in North Lopham, Norfolk - 72y6m, farmer, living with wife Mary (54y11m, farmer's wife), and children James Burwood (27y02m, farmer assisting father), Elsie Mary (24y07m, dairy work assisting father) and Ernest Meredith (16y03m, farming assisting father).⁴¹

James died on 28 Nov 1925 in North Lopham, Norfolk - aged 78.⁴² ⁴³ He had his estate probated on 4 Feb 1926 in Norwich, Norfolk - "GOODERHAM James of North Lopham Norfolk died 28 November 1925 Probate Norwich 4 February [1926] to Mary Gooderham widow and John Coulson Symonds auctioneer. Effects £4306 10s. 6d.".⁴²

Sarah Jane HILL [939], daughter of William HILL (c. 1824-) [997] and Jane Elizabeth HART (c. 1820-) [998], was born on 16 Jun 1849 in Hoxne, Suffolk. 44

She was baptised on 15 Jul 1849.
