Edward FISHER (1777-1819)

Edward FISHER, son of John FISHER (c. 1746-c. 1813) and Pleasance BAMBRIDGE (c. 1743-1827), was born in 1777 in Bressingham, Norfolk. He was baptised on 21 July 1782 in Bressingham - aged 5 years, son of John and Pleasance, baptised with other siblings

He married Elizabeth MOSS on 10 August 1802 in Halesworth, Suffolk.¹

On 8 July 1819. Edward stabbed William HARRISON in the abdomen.

Edward died in August 1819 in Norwich, Norfolk - executed for the stabbing of William Harrison. He was buried on 31 August 1819 in Bressingham - aged 41 years; the ceremony was conducted by James BETTS, clerk²

Spouse and children:

Elizabeth MOSS, daughter of Robert MOSS (-) and Ann (-), was born circa 1780. She died circa 1866.³ She and Edward FISHER had the following children:
