
Arthur George HOGG (c. 1887-1918)

Arthur George Hogg's connection to North Lopham is by birth and residency.

Arthur was one of eight sons of William and Emma. Three of his brothers were also in the military: Arthur was in the army and was killed in action, Edwin was in the army, was a German prisoner of war, but survived, and Herbert was in the Royal Marines Infantry and survived.

Arthur George HOGG, son of William Germany HOGG (c. 1847-) and Emma CLARKE (c. 1850-c. 1924), was born circa 1887 in North Lopham, Norfolk - mother's maiden name CLARKE..¹ He was baptised on 16 October 1887 in Blo Norton, Norfolk - parents William (farmer) and Emma.²

On 5 Apr 1891, (the 1891 Census), he was living at Great Common in North Lopham - 3, living with parents William (44, farmer) and Emma (41), and brothers Herbert (18, farm labourer), Oscar (13, farm labourer), Robert (12, scholar), Edwin (11, scholar), John (10, scholar) and Ernest (7, scholar).³

Arthur appeared in the 1901 Census at Great Common in North Lopham - 14, ordinary agricultural labourer, living with parents William (54, farmer) and Emma (51), and brothers Edwin (20, ordinary agricultural labourer), John (19, ordinary agricultural labourer), Ernest (17, ordinary agricultural labourer) and Albert (11, scholar), and grandmother Eliza CLARKE (80, living on own means).⁴

At the time of the 1911 Census, Arthur was living at 126 Grange Street in Burton-On-Trent, Staffordshire - 25, master's labourer, boarding in the household of Rosanna HALL (43, widow).⁵

No service record for Arthur could be found but he was private 33022, Royal Fusiliers, and then private 23572, 6th Battalion Dorsetshire Regiment.

Arthur died on 8 June 1918.

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission grave registration entry for Arthur was "HOGG, Pte. Arthur, 23572. 6th Bn. Dorsetshire Regt. 8th June, 1918.". (He was formerly Private 33022, Royal Fusiliers.).

Arthur is commemorated at Pozieres Memorial - Panel 54 to 56, stone no. 48, B.
