

Albert Henry MISON (1894-1974)

Albert Henry Mison's connection to North Lopham is by birth and residency.

Albert Henry MISON, son of William MISON (c. 1862-c. 1933) and Anne Lucy MARTIN (c. 1865-c. 1927), was born on 29 November 1894 in South Lopham, Norfolk.^{1 2} He was baptised on 22 September 1895 in South Lopham - parents William and Anne Lucy.¹

At the time of the 1901 Census, Albert was living at Redgrave Road in South Lopham - 6, scholar, living with parents William (39, agricultural labourer) and Anne Lucy (36), and siblings George (15, agricultural labourer), Charles (12), Alice (11, scholar), Emma (10, scholar), Arthur (8, scholar), Lilly (4), Gertrude (3), Edith (2) and Ethel (11m).³

On 2 Apr 1911, (the 1911 Census), he was living at The Ling in Garboldisham, Norfolk - 16, horseman on farm, living with parents William (50, shepherd on farm) and Anne (46), and siblings George (26, cowman on farm), Lilly (14), Gertrude (13), Edith (12), Ethel (10), Ruby (9), Florrie (8), Gladys (5) and Rosy (3).⁴

The only references found for Albert's military service was an absent voter entry for him in North Lopham: "501584 Pte., 429th Ag. Co." and a Campaign Medals entry for Private 501584, Albert Henry Mison, of the Labour Corps, with a previous unit listed as T4/084089 Dvr. R.A.S.C.

Albert married **Bertha STEBBINGS** circa 1917.⁵

The 1921 Census (held on 19 Jun 1921) shows Albert at Uphall Cottages in East Harling, Norfolk - 26y 7m, horseman on farm employed by James Alston, living with wife Bertha (25y 5m, household duties) and son Henry (3y 5m).⁶

Albert was recorded on the 1939 Register living at The Grove Villa, The Grove in Kenninghall, Norfolk - b. 29.11.1894, working foreman on farm,

living with wife Bertha (b. 20.01.1897, unpaid domestic duties) and sons Albert H (b. 22.01.1918, horseman on farm) and Frederick (b. 09.03.1923, labourer on farm).⁷

He died on 5 June 1974 in Kenninghall.⁸

He is commorated in St. Mary's Churchyard, Kenninghall - "IN / LOVING MEMORY OF / A DEAR HUSBAND AND FATHER / BERT HENRY MISON / WHO DIED JUNE 5TH 1974 / AGED 79 YEARS / ALSO HIS BELOVED WIFE / BERTHA / WHO DIED JUNE 28TH 1976 / AGED 79 YEARS / REUNITED".

He had his estate probated on 3 September 1974 in Ipswich, Suffolk - "MISON, Albert Henry of 1 Lopham Rd Kenninghall Norfolk died 5 June 1974 Probate Ipswich 3 September £7766 741021132E."
