George WHARTON was born c. 1783. He died c. 1871. He married **Margaret BUCKENHAM**.

Margaret BUCKENHAM was born c. 1788. She died c. 1865. She and George WHARTON had the following children:

2. **George WHARTON**, son of George WHARTON and Margaret BUCKENHAM, was born on 28 Jul 1807 in North Lopham, Norfolk.

George appeared in the 1841 Census at Half Moon Street in Diss, Norfolk - 35, physician, living with wife Caroline (35), children Caroline (6), George Lee (3), Mary Sophia (2) and Arthur R (4m), and 4 servants

In the 1851 Census (30 Mar 1851) he appeared at Lower Close in St. Faiths, Norfolk - 43, widower, physician, living with children Caroline (15), Jane (14), Arthur P (10) and Kate A (8), and 2 servants

On 7 Apr 1861, (the 1861 Census), he was living at The Grove Villa, The Grove in Bedford, Bedfordshire - 53, widower, physician to infirmary, living with children Jane (24), Arthur P (20, scholar) and Kate A (18, scholar), and 2 servants

At the time of the 1871 Census, George was living at 53 The Grove in Bedford, Bedfordshire - 63, widower, physician at Beds General and Fever Hospital, living with daughter Kate A (28) and 2 servants

George died on 21 Dec 1877. He had his estate probated on 1 Mar 1878 in Northampton, Northamptonshire - "WHARTON George. 1 March [1878]. The Will of George Wharton late of the Grove in the Town and County of Bedford Physician who died 21 December 1877 at the Grove was proved at Northampton by George Lee Wharton of the Grove Esquire and the Reverend Arthur Patteson Wharton of the Vicarage Shipbourne near Tunbridge in the County of Kent Clerk the Sons and Jane Wharton of the Grove Spinster the Daughter the Executors. Personal Estate under £8000.". He married **Caroline LEE**.

Caroline LEE was born c. 1809. She died c. 1846

3. **William WHARTON**, son of George WHARTON and Margaret BUCKENHAM, was born on 27 Oct 1808 in South Lopham, Norfolk.

He married **Elizabeth WOMACK** on 4 Oct 1832 in North Lopham, Norfolk.

William appeared in the 1841 Census in Cressingham, Norfolk - 30, farmer, living with wife Elizabeth (25), children Henry (5), Frederick (3) and Charles (3m), domestic servants Susan BEETON (20), Mary HUNT (15) and Martha BROOKS (14), and Robert LONG (45, agricultural labourer).

In the 1851 Census (30 Mar 1851) he appeared in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 40, farmer, living with wife Elizabeth (36), children Frederick (12, scholar), Edwin C (10, scholar), Frank (5, scholar), Elizabeth A (3) and Thomas W (1), visitor Mical WOMACK (widower, 67), and servants Hannah WALTON (18) and Mary HAUS? (17).

On 7 Apr 1861, (the 1861 Census), he was living at The Lodge in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 50, farmer of the entire parish, living with wife Elizabeth (47), children Francis (15, scholar), Elizabeth Ann (13), Thomas William (11, scholar) and Catherine (9, scholar), governess Julia MURRAY (22), and servants Charlotte KNOCK (27, cook) and Julia JACKSON (20, housemaid).

At the time of the 1871 Census, William was living at Lodge Farm in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 60, farmer of 800 acres, living with wife Elizabeth (57) children Francis (25, farmer's son), Thomas W (21, farmer's son) and Catherine (19), and servants Emma MATTHEWS (21) and Mary Anne HOLDER (17).

He appeared in the 1881 Census at Lodge Farm in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 70, farmer employing 14 men and 6 boys, living with wife Elizabeth (66), daughter Elizabeth A (33), and domestic servants Mary A LOVICK (40) and Francis DOWNING (16).

William appeared in the census on 5 Apr 1891 at College Farm House, Croxton Street in Croxton, Norfolk - 80, widower, farmer and owner of land, living with housekeeper Minnie GILES (24) and general servant Alice LADELL (17). On 13 Jan 1896, (the 1896 Census), he was living in North Lopham, Norfolk - aged 85.

William was buried on 21 Jan 1896 in Riddlesworth, Norfolk. He had his estate probated on 9 Sep 1896 in Norwich, Norfolk - "WHARTON William of North Lopham Norfolk gentleman died 16 January 1896 Probate Norwich 9 September [1896] to Francis Wharton farmer and Vincent Lewis Mathias esquire retired colonel in Her Majesty's army. Effect £1356 1s.".

Elizabeth WOMACK was born c. 1814 in Thelnetham, Suffolk.

At the time of the 1841 Census, Elizabeth was living in Cressingham, Norfolk - 25, living with husband William (30, farmer), children Henry (5), Frederick (3) and Charles (3m), domestic servants Susan BEETON (20), Mary HUNT (15) and Martha BROOKS (14), and Robert LONG (45,

agricultural labourer)

Elizabeth appeared in the 1851 Census in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 36, living with husband William 40, farmer(), children Frederick (12, scholar), Edwin C (10, scholar), Frank (5, scholar), Elizabeth A (3) and Thomas W (1), visitor Mical WOMACK (widower, 67), and servants Hannah WALTON (18) and Mary HAUS? (17)

In the 1861 Census (7 Apr 1861) she appeared at The Lodge in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 47, living with husband William (50, farmer of the entire parish), children Francis (15, scholar), Elizabeth Ann (13), Thomas William (11, scholar) and Catherine (9, scholar), governess Julia MURRAY (22), and servants Charlotte KNOCK (27, cook) and Julia JACKSON (20, housemaid)

On 2 Apr 1871, (the 1871 Census), she was living at Lodge Farm in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 57, living with husband William (60 farmer of 800 acres) children Francis (25, farmer's son), Thomas W (21, farmer's son) and Catherine (19), and servants Emma MATTHEWS (21) and Mary Anne HOLDER (17)

At the time of the 1881 Census, Elizabeth was living at Lodge Farm in Gasthorpe, Norfolk - 66, living with husband William (70, farmer employing 14 men and 6 boys), daughter Elizabeth A (33), and domestic servants Mary A LOVICK (40) and Francis DOWNING (16)

Elizabeth died c. 1889 in Croxton, Norfolk. She was buried on 22 Aug 1889 in Riddlesworth, Norfolk

The marriage was witnessed by George Lee WHARTON and Fanny Florence MATHIAS. The ceremony was conducted by Rev. Thomas T GRIFFITH.

She died on 22 Sep 1873 in Bangalore, Madras, India - aged 31 years. She was buried on 23 Sep 1873 in Bangalore, Madras, India.

Vincent Lewis MATHIAS is the niece's husband of William WHARTON

Vincent Lewis MATHIAS, son of Victor MATHIAS (c. 1794-) and Mary Anne Louisa UNKNOWN (c. 1819-), was born on 5 Apr 1843 in Eastry, Kent. He was baptised on 6 Jul 1843 in Dover, Kent, the ceremony was conducted by Rev. Thomas MORRIS, Rector - parents Vincent (L. Colonel East India Service) and Mary Anne Louisa

Vincent appeared in the 1861 Census at 5 Bedford Terrace in Plymouth, Devon - 7, scholar, living with parents Vincent (57, Lieut Col in the East India Service) and Mary A S (32), siblings Frederick H (9, scholar), Arthur C (3), Mantagur (2) and Elizabeth (1), and house servants Ann HARRIS (37), Catherine THOMAS (22), Susanna H HEED (28 and Sarah RAWLINS (18)

In the London Gazette on 22 Mar 1864 the following notice appeared: "108th Foot, Gentleman Cadet Vincent Lewis Mathias, from the Royal Military College, to be Ensign, vice Augustus Erskine, promoted. Dated 22nd March, 1864."

In 1871 Vincent is listed on the British Army, Worldwide Index as a Lieutenant in the 108th Regiment Of Foot (Madras Infantry) serving at Deesa, India as a Probationer with the Staff Corps

On 17 Aug 1872 there was a newspaper report in the Bedfordshire Mercury:

August 14, at Letherhead, by the Rev. T. T. Griffith, M.A., vicar, and the Rev. A. P. Wharton, M.A., brother of the bride, V. LEWIS MATHIAS, Esq., Madras Staff Corps, second son of the late Col. Vincent Mathias, Madras Army, to KATE ANNE, youngest daughter of GEORGE WHARTON, Esq., M.D., of Bedford, Physician to the Beds. General and Fever Hospitals.

On 26 Mar 1877 Vincent is listed on the British Arm Lists as a captain in the Madras Staff Corps. In

the London Gazette on 29 Jun 1877 the following notice appeared: To Be Captain. Lieutenant Brevet Captain Vincent Lewis Mathias. Dated 26 March. 1877. In 1888 Vincent is in Harts Army List as a Lieutenant Colonel Retired On Full Or Retired Pay Or On A Pension (Lieut Col on 25.06.1885)

He married Emma LEMOINE on 30 Oct 1889 in St. Leonards, Sussex.

On 1 Nov 1889 there was a newspaper report in the St. James Gazette:

MATHIAS - LEMOINE. - At St. Mary Magdalen's, St. Leonards-on-Sea, Lieut.-Colonel Vincent Lewis Mathias (retired), Madras Staff Corps, son of the late Colonel Vincent Mathias, to Emma, daughter of the late Mr. William Lemoine, Oct. 30.

In the 1891 Census (5 Apr 1891) he appeared at 4 Goldington Avenue in Bedford, Bedfordshire - 47, retired army Lt. Col., living with wife Emma (34), son Frederick V L (17, scholar) and general servant Margaret A CHARTER (21)

Vincent married Marion DURRANT c. 1899 - reg: Plymouth Devon.

On 31 Mar 1901, (the 1901 Census), he was living at St. Marys, Underwood in Plympton St. Mary, Devon - 59, retired army Lt. Col., living with wife Marion (29) and domestic servant Sarah LAMBERT (62)

At the time of the 1921 Census, Vincent was living at 9 Cecil Avenue in Bournemouth, Hampshire - 78, retired army Lt. Col. Madras Staff Corps, living with wife Marion (49)

Vincent died on 27 Dec 1927 in Bournemouth. He had his estate probated on 23 Feb 1928 in London - "MATHIAS Vincent Lewis of 22 Cecil-avenue Bournemouth died 27 December 1927 Probate London 23 February to Marion Mathias widow. Effects £587 8s. 10d."
