Dear Madam,

Drainage Works: Chequers Road Housing Site.

As the Council have provided a piped water supply to these houses they have now to deal with the provision of a small sewage treatment works.

I am to ask if you will be good enough to assist them by granting the following easements:-

- a. The right in perpetuity of a foot access over the route shown coloured blue on the enclosed plan in field O.S.No.440. (This will be enable workmen to get to the small works proposed to be sited in field O.S.392).
- b. The right to construct and maintain an underground septic tank, with in and out connecting drains, as shown in red. (Although the tank proper will be below ground, there will be covers at ground level which will prevent cultivation of a small piece of land about 5ft. x 5ft - therefore we should site the tank as close to the hedge as possible).

The Council cannot discuss terms directly themselves, so I have asked the District Valuer to communicate with you.

The Council hope that you will help them as asked: once the whole works are completed I do not think you will be inconvenienced at all.
