
John YOUNGMAN (c. 1823-1888)

1. **John YOUNGMAN**, son of John YOUNGMAN (c. 1793-c. 1849) and Sarah MORLEY (-), was born c. 1823 in Walsham Le Willow, Suffolk. He was baptised on 29 Apr 1823 in Walsham Le Willow - parents John and Sarah. He appeared in the census in 1841 in Walsham Le Willow - 15, living with parents John (45, butcher) and Sarah (40), siblings James (15), Phillip (12), Frederick (9), George (7), William (5) and Sarah (2), and servant Sarah WALES (15). He married Mary A WILEMER c. 1848. He appeared in the census in 1851 at Church Hill in Winfarthing, Norfolk - 27, farmer of 79 acres employing 2 men, living with wife Mary A (23) and servant Ann Flatman (20). In 1855 the Electoral Register showed him living at Church Hill Farm in Winfarthing - £50 occupier of Church Hill Farm, Winfarthing. John appeared in the census in 1861 at The Street in Winfarthing - 37, farmer of 79 acres employing 4 men and 3 boys, living with wife Mary M (34), servant Rhoda MOORE (18) and John GARDENER (23, teamster). In 1865 the Electoral Register showed him living at Church Hill Farm in Winfarthing - £50 occupier of Church Hill Farm, Winfarthing. John appeared in the census in 1871 at Church Street in Winfarthing - widower, 47, farmer of 132 acres employing 4 men and 5 boys, living with housekeeper Charlotte THURSTON (31, general servant). In 1875 the Electoral Register showed him living at Church Hill Farm in Winfarthing - £50 occupier of Church Hill Farm, Winfarthing. John appeared in the census in 1881 at Church Lane in Winfarthing - 57, farmer of 152 acres employing 4 men 2 boys and 2 women, living with wife Louisa Maria (54) and servant Emily HOWES (20). In 1885 the Electoral Register showed him living at Church Hill Farm in Winfarthing - freehold house and land, Church Hill Farm, Winfarthing. In 1888 the Electoral Register showed him living at Church Hill Farm in Winfarthing - freehold house and land, Church Hill Farm, Winfarthing (also noted as a Shelfanger occupational voter as he had land in Back Lane Shelfanger). John died on 2 Feb 1888 in Winfarthing - age 64 years. He was buried on 8 Feb 1888 in Winfarthing, the ceremony was conducted by Rev. J. A. DOUGHERTY, curate. He had his estate probated on 26 Mar 1888 in Norwich, Norfolk - "YOUNGMAN John. 26 March [1888]. Adminidtration (with the Will) of the personal estate of John Youngmam late of Winfarthing in the County of Norfolk Farmer who died 2 February 1888 at Winfarthing as granted at Norwich to Louisa Maria Youngman of Winfarthing Widow the Relict the Universal Legatee. Personal estate £620 19s. 6d.". He is commoratedWinfarthing- "MARY ANN / Wife of JOHN YOUNGMAN / Died 3rd MARCH 1868 Aged 41 years. / In loving remembrance of / JOHN YOUNGMAN / Died February 22nd 1888 Ages 61 years.". He married Louisa Maria UNKNOWN.

Mary A WILEMER was born in 1828 in Great Ellingham, Norfolk. She died on 3 Mar 1868 in Winfarthing.

Louisa Maria UNKNOWN was born c. 1827 in Staplehurst, Kent. She died c. 1899.
